I spent time with Gillian and the family after Vanessa's graduation and we built treasured memories. Debbie's Alayna, 15, and Katie, 13, (Jonathan's sisters) miss him so much. Rachel now has two girls: Zoe, soon to be three years old and Avery five months. Maxine continues to devote her life to being there for her daughters, Rachel and Debbie, during these child rearing years. What a blessing. My sister, June from Virginia, spent Christmas with me. She is amazing!

My precious husband, Brucie, has had many ups and downs, as is usual with Parkinsons, but he has overcome and is resuming his ministry at the long term care facility of praying for others and singing. It is my joy to be there for him and we are very much in love. The Lord gave me the idea of initiating a Family Support Group there which is called The Branch (John 15—abiding in the vine) and is facilitated by the Chaplain. I enjoy ministering and being God's light to the residents, their family members and staff. The residents loved the Valentine's Day stuffed dogs.

It is one year since the movie Unplanned, which revealed the truth about the abortion industry. How can we be involved, other than prayer? I attend their outreaches here like Walk for Life and plan to be a counselor with a Clinic when it opens a branch closer to me. 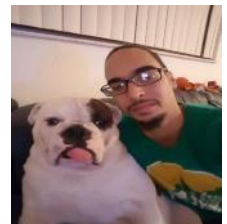
